On October 1, 2024, Union Defence Minister Rajnath Singh accorded a warm send-off to the "Vayu Veer Vijaeta" car rally from the National War Memorial in New Delhi. This rally is organized to commemorate the 92nd anniversary of the Indian Air Force (IAF), which will be celebrated on October 8, 2024.

- The rally will officially begin from Thoise in Ladakh, one of the highest altitude air force stations in the world, situated at 3.068 meters above mean sea level, on October 8, 2024. It will conclude in Tawang, Arunachal Pradesh, on October 29, 2024.

Main Points:-

(i) The IAF also organized an airshow themed "Saksham, Sashakta, Amtanirbhar" (Potent, Powerful, Self-reliant) at Marina Beach in Chennai, Tamil Nadu, on October 6, 2024. This event was one of the largest airshows ever conducted by the IAF.

Eight products from Assam's Bodo Tribe have been granted GI tag.

The Geographical Indications (GI) Registry, located in Chennai, Tamil Nadu, and operating under the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) within the Ministry of Commerce & Industry (MoCI), has officially granted the GI tag to eight products originating from Assam.

- The eight newly recognized GI products are: Jou Gwran, Maibra Jou Bidwi, Jou Gishi, Napham (fermented fish), Ondla/Onla, Gwkha Gwkhwi, Narzi, and Aronai.
- These products include traditional food items and distinctive varieties of rice beer, showcasing the rich cultural practices and culinary heritage of the Bodo Tribe of Assam.

Main Points:-

- (i) The Bodo Traditional Brewers Association applied for Geographical Indication tags for three rice beer variants. The first, 'Bodo Jou Gwran,' has the highest alcohol content (about 16.11%) among Bodo rice beers.
- (ii) The second, 'Maibra Jou Bidwi' (locally 'Maibra Jwu Bidwi'), is valued and often served as a welcome drink by many Bodo tribes.

FCI introduces ANNA DARPAN: a new era of digital transformation in supply chain management.

The Food Corporation of India (FCI), under the Department of Food & Public Distribution (Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food, and Public Distribution), has launched a comprehensive digital transformation initiative. - The program was organized to mark the successful completion of 10 years of the Swachh Bharat Mission (SBM), which is one of the most significant mass movements for cleanliness in India.
- During the event, PM Modi launched and laid the foundation stone for several sanitation and cleanliness projects, totaling over Rs 9,600 crore.

Main Points:-

- (i) Theme of SHS 2024: 'Swabhav Swachhata- Sanskar Swachhata'.
- (ii) Additionally, the SHS 2024 campaign, observed across India from 17th September 2024 to 2nd October 2024, successfully concluded with the Swachh Bharat Diwas program.

── MoH&FW has increased the monthly nutrition support for TB patients to Rs 1,000.

On 7th October 2024, Union Minister Jagat Prakash (JP) Nadda, from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoH&FW), announced significant enhancements to nutritional support for tuberculosis (TB) patients. These initiatives aim to improve the health and recovery of TB patients and their household contacts.

- The Ni-Kshay Poshan Yojana (NPY) has raised the monthly nutritional support from Rs. 500 per patient to Rs. 1,000 per patient throughout their treatment.
- The initiative will incur an additional cost of Rs. 1,040 crores, to be shared between the central and state governments at a ratio of 60:40.

Main Points:-

- (i) This will be introduced for all patients with a Body Mass Index (BMI) below 18.5 kg/m² at the time of diagnosis. Under NPY, TB patients will receive a total nutritional support ranging from Rs. 3,000 to Rs. 6,000 annually. Approximately 25 lakh TB patients will benefit from this, including 12 lakh individuals who are underweight.
- (ii) To date, Rs. 3,202 crores have been disbursed to 1.13 crore beneficiaries through Direct Benefit Transfer (DBT) under NPY.
- (iii) India aims to eliminate tuberculosis by 2025, ahead of the global target of 2030 for sustainable development.

The Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission has completed three transformative years in advancing digital health.

On September 27, 2024, the Ayushman Bharat Digital Mission (ABDM), a crucial part of Ayushman Bharat (AB) — the flagship scheme of the Government of India (GoI) that originated from the National Health Policy of 2017 — successfully completed three years of implementation.

- Launched by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on September 27, 2021, the mission aims to transform the country's digital healthcare ecosystem, enhancing accessibility, efficiency, and transparency in healthcare services.
- Additionally, over 42 crore health records have been linked to ABHA, facilitating seamless access to medical histories and improving healthcare delivery.

Main Points:-

To date, over 67 crore Ayushman Bharat Health Accounts (ABHA) have been created. These accounts are designed to provide citizens with unique digital health IDs, ensuring secure access to and sharing of their health records.

On September 30, 2024, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) Dr. Jitendra Singh announced the establishment of Thematic Hubs (T-Hubs) and Technical Groups for the National Quantum Mission (NQM) during a video conference at a ceremony in New Delhi.

- The initiative includes the creation of four T-Hubs, consisting of 14 Technical Groups and 17 Project Teams, spread across 17 states and 2 Union Territories in India.
- These hubs will unite a total of 152 researchers from 43 institutions, including 31 institutes of national importance, 8 research laboratories, 1 university, and 3 private institutes across the country.

Main Points:-

- (i) Additionally, the Ministry for Science and Technology launched 'Bharat Gen,' an innovative initiative in generative Artificial Intelligence (AI) aimed at transforming public service delivery and enhancing citizen engagement.
- (ii) This project represents the world's first government-funded Multimodal Large Language Model (LLM) initiative, focused on creating efficient and inclusive AI solutions in Indian languages.

Assam Becomes the First State to Introduce Co-Districts as a New Administrative Framework.

Assam has taken a pioneering step by becoming the first state in India to launch and operationalize Co-Districts, an innovative initiative aimed at decentralizing district administration and bringing governance closer to the grassroots. Co-Districts serve as targeted administrative

units within a district.

- A total of 21 Co-Districts were launched across Assam, with the goal of making governance and administrative services more accessible to citizens.
- Chief Minister Himanta Biswa Sarma initiated this administrative reform in 2023, replacing the previous system of 24 civil sub-divisions.

Main Points:-

- (i) The government plans to establish Co-District offices in all 126 assembly constituencies in Assam.
- (ii) On October 4, 2024, Phase 1 of this initiative was launched, followed by the inauguration of 18 Co-Districts on October 5, 2024.

On October 7, 2024, Union Minister Jagat Prakash Nadda, from the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoH&FW), addressed the 77th session of the World Health Organization (WHO) Southeast Asia Region (SEARO) in New Delhi.

- The WHO SEARO meeting included the election of office bearers, the establishment of a "Drafting Group for Resolutions and Decisions," the adoption of "Special Procedures" to regulate session conduct, and the approval of the provisional agenda.

Main Points:-

- (i) The 77th session of the Regional Committee (RC77) for Southeast Asia took place from October 7 to 9, 2024.
- (ii) In his inaugural address, Union Minister JP Nadda emphasized that India's health system adopts a "whole of government" and "whole of society" approach to achieve Universal Health Coverage (UHC), focusing on strengthening primary healthcare and essential services.

— Union Cabinet Approves Proposals on October 9, 2024, Chaired by PM Narendra Modi.

On October 9, 2024, the Union Cabinet, chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, approved several significant proposals aimed at enhancing infrastructure and security.

- The cabinet sanctioned the development of the world-class National Maritime Heritage Complex (NMHC) at Lothal, Gujarat, to be executed in two phases by the Ministry of Ports, Shipping & Waterways (MoPSW).

- Additionally, approved the construction of 2,280 km of roads in Rajasthan and Punjab, with an investment of ₹4,406 crore.

Main Points:-

- (i) The cabinet also decided to continue the universal supply of Fortified Rice Kernels (FRK) under various Central Government schemes, including the Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Anna Yojana (PMGKAY), from July 2024 to December 2028, at a cost of ₹17,082 crore.
- (ii) In terms of national security, the Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS) approved deals for the procurement of 31 MQ-9B High Altitude Long Endurance (HALE) Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) from General Atomics of the USA, along with the indigenous construction of two Nuclear Attack Submarines (SSN), further strengthening India's defense capabilities.

The Interest Equalisation Scheme (IES) has been extended for three months, with a cap set at Rs 50 lakh.

The Directorate General of Foreign Trade (DGFT) has extended the Interest Equalisation Scheme (IES) for pre- and post-shipment rupee export credit for an additional three months, now lasting until December 31, 2024, to promote India's outbound shipments.

- The scheme is fund-limited, with earlier benefits for individual exporters capped at Rs 10 crore per annum per Import Export Code (IEC). This cap has now been raised to Rs 50 lakh.
- The DGFT has announced that fiscal benefits for each Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises (MSME) will be capped at Rs 50 lakh in total for the fiscal year 2024-25, valid until December 2024.
- MSME manufacturer exporters who have already received an equalisation benefit of Rs 50 lakh or more by September 30, 2024, will not be eligible for any further benefits during the extended period.

Main Points:-

This scheme was initiated on April 1, 2015, originally valid for five years until March 31, 2020, and has since been extended multiple times with additional fund allocations.

PM Narendra Modi Unveils Development Initiatives in Hazaribag, Jharkhand.

On October 2, 2024, marking Mahatma Gandhi's birth anniversary, Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched the Dharti Aaba Janjatiya Gram Utkarsh Abhiyan (DAJGUA) from Hazaribag, Jharkhand, with a significant investment of over ₹79,156 crores.

- During the event, PM Modi inaugurated and laid the foundation for various projects aimed at empowering tribal communities in Hazaribag.
- Additionally, he initiated multiple projects under the Pradhan Mantri Janjati Adivasi Nyaya Maha Abhiyan (PM-JANMAN), amounting to over ₹1,360 crores.

Main Points:-



- (i) According to a statement from the Prime Minister's Office, the project will benefit more than 5 crore tribals in 549 districts across 30 states and Union Territories.
- (ii) The scheme seeks to address critical gaps in social infrastructure, health, education, and livelihood through 25 interventions implemented by 17 central ministries and departments.

- Under the Atmanirbhar Bharat initiative, MeitY's Research and Development (R&D) organizations have provided indigenously developed products to MCTE for military purposes.
- This partnership aims to strengthen collaborative efforts for joint R&D in areas such as Artificial Intelligence (AI), Quantum Technology, Chip Design, Fifth Generation (5G) and beyond, as well as strategic electronics and communications.
- It will accelerate the adoption of advanced technologies to address the evolving needs and challenges of the Indian Army (IA).

— DoT and Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) have launched a new system to combat fraudulent calls.

The Department of Telecommunications (DoT), under the Ministry of Communications (MoC), has collaborated with major Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) to launch a two-tiered system aimed at addressing the rising issue of telecom fraud. This fraud involves scammers manipulating Caller Line Identification (CLI) to carry out financial scams.

- The system is designed to identify and block incoming international calls that appear to be from Indian mobile numbers. This is important for stopping scams before they reach consumers.

Main Points:-



All four TSPs have successfully implemented the system. Approximately one-third of the total spoofed calls, amounting to 4.5 million, are being prevented from entering the Indian telecom network.

- (i) During this visit, India and Jamaica exchanged four 4 Memorandums of Understanding (MoUs) in the areas of Digital Public Infrastructure, Cultural Exchange, and Sports.
- (ii) This historic visit includes meetings with PM Modi, President Murmu, and Vice President Dhankhar.

He launched several initiatives worth about ₹23,300 crore in agriculture and animal husbandry sectors in Washim, Maharashtra and also inaugurated over 7,500 projects worth over ₹1,920 crore under the Agriculture Infrastructure Fund (AIF).

- In Thane, PM Modi inaugurated and laid the foundation stones for several initiatives exceeding ₹32,800 crore, aimed primarily at enhancing urban mobility in the Mumbai Metropolitan Region (MMR).

India has joined the International Medical Device Regulators Forum (IMDRF) as an affiliate member, with the Central Drugs Standard Control Organisation (CDSCO) under the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare (MoH&FW) receiving the Affiliate Membership.

- India's application for affiliate membership was reviewed during the 26th Session of IMDRF, held in September 2024 in Seattle, Washington, USA.
- This membership will enhance India's global collaboration in medical device regulation. It will strengthen the competitiveness of India's domestic industry while promoting "Brand India" on the international stage.

Main Points:-

- (i) The IMDRF, established in 2011 aims to accelerate international regulatory harmonization and convergence for medical devices.
- (ii) Its members include regulatory authorities from the USA, Australia, Canada, the European Union (EU), Japan, the United Kingdom (UK), Brazil, Russia, China, South Korea, Singapore, and the World Health Organization (WHO).
- (iii) The IMDRF Chair and Secretariat rotate annually among the jurisdictions of Management Committee members.

Secretary Gina Raimondo and Piyush Goyal co-chaired the 6th U.S.-India Commercial **Dialogue Meeting.**

On October 3, 2024, Union Minister Piyush Goyal from the Ministry of Commerce and Industry (MoCI) and Gina Raimondo, the U.S. Secretary of Commerce, co-chaired the 6th consecutive India-U.S. Commercial Dialogue at the U.S. Department of Commerce in Washington, D.C.

- Piyush Goyal visited the U.S. from September 30 to October 3, 2024, at the invitation of Gina Raimondo.

Main Points:-

- (i) Shri Goyal and Secretary Raimondo will talk about improving critical minerals supply chains between India and the USA, aiming to sign a MoU for better collaboration.
- (ii) Minister Goyal will meet USTR (United States Trade Representative) Ambassador Katherine Tai in Washington, DC, to discuss enhancing bilateral trade.

The Bilateral Investment Treaty between India and the UAE is now in effect.

The Bilateral Investment Treaty (BIT) between India and the United Arab Emirates (UAE) came into effect on August 31, 2024. This treaty was signed in Abu Dhabi on February 13, 2024.

- The BIT replaces the earlier Bilateral Investment Promotion and Protection Agreement (BIPPA), which expired on September 12, 2024. This ensures continued investment protection for investors from both nations. BIPPA was originally signed in December 2013.
- The India-UAE BIT 2024 includes a closed asset-based investment definition, fair treatment guarantees, ISDS provisions, exclusions for taxation, and protections against corruption and expropriation.

Main Points:-

- (i) The UAE ranks 7th among countries, accounting for 3% of the total Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) received in India. From April 2000 to June 2024, the UAE invested approximately USD 19 billion in India.

The National Space Commission, India's top authority for space missions, has given the green light for the Lunar Polar Exploration Mission (Lupex), marking India's fifth lunar mission. This mission will be a collaborative effort between the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) and Japan's Japan Aerospace Exploration Agency (JAXA).

- The mission will land at the Moon's south pole to investigate water and other resources, as well as analyze the interaction of water with lunar regolith.
- JAXA will develop the rover and launch vehicle, while ISRO will create the lander system. The Lupex rover will weigh approximately 350 kg, making it much larger than the 26 kg Pragyan rover from Chandrayaan-3.

- (i) Lupex aims for a lunar surface duration of up to 100 days, significantly longer than Chandrayaan-3's 20 days.
- (ii) As part of Lupex, ISRO's Liquid Propulsion Systems Centre (LPSC) will develop a new lander engine designed for potential human landings on the Moon.

Poavid Baker, Demis Hassabis, and John Jumper have been awarded the Nobel Prize in Chemistry 2024.

American biochemist David Baker, Demis Hassabis, CEO of DeepMind Technologies Limited (a subsidiary of Google), and American chemist John Jumper received this honor from the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences in Stockholm, Sweden, on October 9, 2024.

- David Baker was recognized "for computational protein design," while Demis Hassabis and John Jumper were awarded "for protein structure prediction."

Main Points:-

- (i) David Baker has accomplished the remarkable feat of designing entirely new types of proteins, showcasing innovative advancements in protein engineering.
- (ii) Demis Hassabis and John Jumper have created an AI model that addresses a 50-year-old challenge in science: predicting the complex structures of proteins. These groundbreaking discoveries hold immense potential for future applications.
- (iii) The prize amount is 11 million Swedish kronor, with half going to David Baker and the other half shared between Demis Hassabis and John Jumper.

Veteran Indian industrialist and philanthropist Ratan Naval Tata, Chairman Emeritus of Tata Sons, passed away at the age of 86 at Breach Candy Hospital in Mumbai, Maharashtra. He was born on December 28, 1937, in Bombay Presidency, British India (now known as

Mumbai).

- Ratan Tata was awarded the Padma Bhushan, India's third highest civilian honor, in 2000, and the Padma Vibhushan, India's second highest civilian honor, in 2008 by the Government of India for his outstanding contributions to trade and industry.
- Karnataka Minister G Parameshwara on Thursday paid a heartfelt tribute to Ratan Tata, hailing him as a pioneer who transformed India's industry landscape and built a strong foundation for Indian industries.

Main Points:-

- (i) .He was bestowed with the Oslo Business for Peace Award in 2010.
- (ii) Under Ratan Tata's leadership, Tata Motors launched the Tata Indica, India's first indigenously designed passenger car, in 1998.

── World Teachers' Day observed on 5 October.

The United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO) celebrates World Teacher's Day (WTD) each year on October 5 to honor the crucial contributions of teachers and their role in shaping future generations.

- This day highlights the challenges faced by teachers, raises awareness of their vital role, and allows students to express gratitude for their impactful guidance.

Main Points:-

- (i) The theme for World Teacher's Day 2024 is "Valuing Teacher Voices: Towards a New Social Contract for Education."
- (ii) World Teachers' Day was established by UNESCO in 1994.

International Day of Non-Violence - October 2, 2024

The International Day of Non-Violence, observed annually on October 2, commemorates the birthday of Mahatma Gandhi, the leader of the Indian Independence Movement known for his philosophy of non-violence and peace.

- October 2, 2024, marks the 155th anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi's birth and the 18th International Day of Non-Violence.

Main Points:-

- (i)This day was established by the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) through resolution A/RES/61/271 on June 15, 2007, following a proposal by Iranian Nobel Laureate Shirin Ebadi in June 2004.
- (ii) In India, October 2 is observed as "Gandhi Jayanti".

American physicist John J. Hopfield and British-Canadian computer scientist Geoffrey E. Hinton were jointly awarded the Nobel Prize in Physics 2024 by the Royal Swedish Academy of

Sciences in Stockholm, Sweden, on October 8, 2024.

- Hopfield created an associative memory system that can store and reconstruct data patterns. In contrast, Hinton developed techniques enabling networks to autonomously identify data characteristics and carry out tasks like image recognition.

Main Points:-

- (i) The prize amount of 11 million Swedish kronor will be equally divided between the laureates.
- (ii) John J. Hopfield and Geoffrey E. Hinton were received the award "for foundational discoveries and inventions that enable machine learning with artificial neural networks."



The Bangladesh cricket team, led by Najmul Hossain Shanto, is touring India in September and October 2024 to compete against India. The tour features 2 Test matches and 3 Twenty20 Internationals (T20Is).

- The Indian Men's Cricket team, captained by Rohit Sharma, won the two-match Test series against Bangladesh with a 2-0 scoreline.

Main Points:-

- (i) This victory marks Team India's 180th win in Test history.
- (ii) With this win, India secured 4th place on the list of most Test victories, which is topped by Australia (414), followed by England (397) and West Indies (183).

— American biologists Victor Ambros and Gary Ruvkun have been awarded the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine for 2024.

Victor Ambros (an American developmental biologist) and Gary Bruce Ruvkun (an American molecular biologist) were jointly awarded the Nobel Prize in Physiology or Medicine 2024 by the Nobel Assembly at Karolinska Institutet in Stockholm, Sweden.

- They were honored "for the discovery of microRNA and its role in post-transcriptional gene regulation."
- Ruvkun and Ambros discovered the first microRNA and published their findings in the journal Cell in 1993. This discovery sparked a scientific revolution. Their work has had a significant impact on scientists around the world, helping to guide research on diseases like cancer and diabetes.

Main Points:-

(i) The award announcement was made by the Royal Swedish Academy of Sciences on October 7, 2024.

International Translation Day 2024 is observed on September 30.

The United Nations (UN) observes International Translation Day (ITD) every year on September

30 to honor the contributions of language professionals. Their work is essential for uniting nations, fostering communication, understanding, cooperation, supporting development, and enhancing global peace and security.

- On May 24, 2017, the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) passed a resolution establishing this day. Eleven countries signed this resolution, recognizing the importance of the work done by language experts.
- September 30 was chosen to commemorate these experts because it coincides with the feast day of St. Jerome, who is credited with translating the Bible. He was a priest from northeastern Italy who translated Greek manuscripts of the New Testament into Latin.

Main Points:-

(i) The theme for ITD 2024 is "Translation, an art worth protecting: Moral and Material Rights for Indigenous Languages."

Iran has unveiled the powerful suicide drone known as 'Shahed-136B.'

Iran, for the first time, showcased the "Shahed 136B," a one-way attack drone known as a 'kamikaze' or 'suicide' drone, alongside the "Jihad," a single-stage liquid-fuel ballistic missile, during the Armed Forces military parade in September 2024. This event commemorated the anniversary of the start of the 1980-88 war with Iraq.

- The Shahed 136B, the latest Iranian-made drone, is an upgraded version of the Shahed-136, featuring new enhancements and an operational range of over 4,000 kilometers.
- Due to its compact design, the Shahed-136 can be transported in large numbers and quickly deployed from moving vehicles.

Main Points:-

The Jihad missile has a high-explosive detachable warhead and a range of 1,000 kilometers. It was designed and manufactured by the aerospace division of Iran's Revolutionary Guards.



Tata Electronics Private Limited (TEPL) has finalized a Definitive Agreement with Taiwan's Powerchip Semiconductor Manufacturing Corporation (PSMC) for the establishment of India's first semiconductor fabrication plant in Dholera, Gujarat. This facility will be Al-enabled and built as a greenfield project.

- PSMC will provide a comprehensive range of technologies and engineering support to facilitate the transfer of these technologies to the new fab in Gujarat.
- The project entails a total investment of up to Rs 91,000 crores (USD 11 billion) and is expected to generate over 20,000 skilled jobs, both directly and indirectly.

Main Points:-

The semiconductor fab will produce chips for various applications, including Power Management Integrated Circuits (ICs), Display Drivers, Microcontroller Units (MCUs), and high-performance computing logic, catering to the increasing demand in sectors such as AI, automotive, computing, data storage, and wireless communication.

World Heart Day (WHD) is celebrated globally on September 29,2024.

World Heart Day (WHD) is celebrated globally on September 29 each year to raise awareness about cardiovascular diseases (CVDs), including heart disease and stroke, and to encourage actions for their prevention, detection, and management.

- Cardiovascular diseases remain a significant global health challenge responsible for over 18 million deaths each year.
- The burden is especially significant in the WHO South-East Asia Region, where cardiovascular diseases (CVDs) cause 3.9 million deaths each year, mainly from heart attacks and strokes. This accounts for 30% of all deaths in the region, with almost half occurring prematurely, before the age of 70.

Main Points:-

(i) The theme for World Heart Day 2024 is "Use Heart for Action."

The Tripura government has launched the CM-SATH Scheme to assist meritorious students in pursuing higher education.

Prof. Dr. Manik Saha, the Chief Minister of Tripura, inaugurated this scheme, which aims to provide financial support to deserving students.

- Under the scheme, financial assistance of ₹60,000 (₹5,000 per month) will be granted to a total of 200 students—100 at the Madhyamik level for two years and 100 at the Higher Secondary level for three years.
- The initiative is designed to support talented students and ensure that financial challenges do not impede their education.

Main Points:-

- (i) The selection will include 152 students from the block level, 12 from the Nagar Panchayat level, 26 from the Municipal Council level, and 10 from the Agartala Municipal Corporation level, ensuring representation from various areas and levels.
- (ii) This support is merit-based to encourage higher education, with beneficiaries selected by the District Education Officer of each district.

The Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO), in collaboration with researchers from the Indian Institute of Technology (IIT) Delhi, has developed the 'ABHED' (Advanced Ballistics for High Energy Defeat), a lightweight bulletproof jacket.

- The jacket is constructed from polymers and indigenous boron carbide ceramic material. The armor plates have successfully passed all necessary Research and Development (R&D) trials according to established protocols.
- The jacket weighs 8.2 kilograms (kgs) and 9.5 kgs for different Bureau of Indian Standards (BIS) levels.

Main Points:-

ABHED was created at the DRDO Industry Academia Center of Excellence (DIA-CoE) at IIT Delhi.

Covernment launched Prime Minister's Internship Scheme 2024.

On October 3, 2024, the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) is collaborating with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) to launch the pilot phase of the "Prime Minister's Internship Scheme 2024." This initiative, part of the 2024-2025 budget, aims to provide 1.25 lakh internships for Indian youth, with a budget of approximately Rs 800 crore for the Financial Year 2024-25 (FY25).

- The scheme's goal is to create one crore internships by March 2029, offering financial assistance of Rs 60,000 per annum over five years.
